St. Francis de Sales Fix-It Campaign - First Pledge Update

On Monday, May 22, the Feast of St. Rita of Cascia, repairs will begin on the first of our Fix-It Campaign priorities: The repairs to the roof of the Ministry Center. After the parish school concludes for the academic year in early June, repairs of the school roof will begin. These are two of our eight projects in the Fix-It Campaign.
