



~ Anamnesis ~

"The word he used for memory does not mean: "I remember what I had for breakfast."

The definition of **anamnesis** is to make a past event become present now.

This is why, as Catholics, we can say that the bread and wine actually become the Body and Blood of Christ. Not because we made it up, but because Jesus said so himself. In his own words, Jesus said that when one of you (the twelve apostles who become priests on Holy Thursday and later ordained other priests) do this, you will make the moment of my offering on the Cross present and real" (Thomas Griffin, Ascension Press, 2021).
